

Website Development Project Minutes

Meeting Summary:

1. Discussed Sean Kelly's IPDA website home page and project page mockups posted on: "Making a home for projects on the site" at:

In general, all theme samples look good and are big improvement of current site. Their designs with flexible wide allow free flowing and filling the browser page nicely when being resized. It was unanimously agreed that the "Blue" home and project sample are the best and go well with the existing IPDA logo.

We need to keep the current IPDA logo even though we all agree that it can be improved. Dan will take it to the Steering Committee if it can be changed. But it is not part of our web project.

We need to keep in mind the type of users and usage the web site is serving: IPDA community – collaboration; boarder community –what standards it generates; general public – what IPDA is all about; project members – support project development.

There was discussion how best to rename "Documents" and what it should contain, and whether it should be grouped by category of information, type of media versus project highlights.

There should be a Steering Committee (SC) private area that only SC members have access to post work in progress. All other areas are publicly available.

We need a simple Standards page that includes a table of standards artifacts (name, version, published date, status, etc). The Standards page will be controlled by the SC and only approved standards documentation (architecture, standards, specifications) will be posted on this page and visible to all. All other pages (except SC area) will be editable by all IPDA members with login, and their contents are immediately publicly visible. The contents can be made "published" as approved items.

2. Kelly to prototype the home, project, standards, and document pages and Emily will help populate the content for discuss at the next telecom.
